Program Title: A collaborative approach to optimize outcomes for patients with compromised dental aesthetics.

Program Description:

Today, many of our patients are seeking dental treatment to correct specific anterior aesthetic concerns. Often, these patients may present with treatment challenges that include missing or compromised teeth, altered levels of periodontal attachment or deficient ridge form. Therefore, treatment planning can be difficult and typically requires a collaborative approach to care to achieve the desired outcome. Drs. Jim Janakievski & Oscar Ramirez will discuss interdisciplinary protocols used to optimize anterior aesthetics for our patients.
